

Adult Inpatient Program

- One small bag of casual clothing – no clothing with drawstrings or revealing clothing (tank tops, shorts shorter than mid-thigh, mini skirts, hats)
- Limited toiletries (no glass or mirrors)
 - non-electric toothbrush
 - new, unopened toothpaste
 - alcohol-free hairspray (non-aerosol)
 - new, sealed shampoo, conditioner, soap
 - new, sealed deodorant (non-aerosol)
 - make-up in original plastic bottles
 - alcohol-free mouthwash or breath spray
 - new, sealed package of tampons and sanitary pads
 - alcohol-free water-based perfume or cologne
 - cordless electric razors
 - hair dryer (held by staff)
- No dental floss, hand sanitizers, curling irons, razors, tweezers, nail polish or polish remover
- No flip-flops
- High heeled shoes are permitted at staff discretion
- Musical instruments are permitted at staff discretion
- No jewelry, including body piercings, except a watch and wedding band are permitted
- No food or candy
- No lighters
- New unopened packages of cigarettes
- Maximum of 2 magazines and/or books (with appropriate content as approved by the nursing staff)
- Maximum \$30 cash

Please note patients admitted to the Acute Care Unit (ACU) are not permitted to have belts or shoelaces.
