

## **Adult Inpatient Program**

- One small bag of casual clothing – no clothing with drawstrings or revealing clothing (sleeveless shirts, tank tops, shorts and skirts shorter than finger length, flip flops, high heeled shoes, hats)
- Limited toiletries (no glass or mirrors)
  - manual or battery operated toothbrush
  - new, unopened toothpaste
  - new, unopened alcohol-free hairspray (non-aerosol)
  - new, unused shampoo, conditioner, soap
  - new, sealed deodorant (non-aerosol)
  - new, sealed make-up in original plastic bottles
  - new, unopened alcohol-free mouthwash or breath spray
  - new, unused shaving cream
  - new, sealed package of tampons and sanitary pads
  - new, unopened alcohol-free water-based perfume or cologne in original plastic bottle
  - cordless electric razors
  - hair dryer (held by staff)
- No dental floss, cotton balls, q-tips, make-up removal pads, hand sanitizers, curling irons, razors, tweezers, nail polish or polish remover
- Musical instruments are permitted at unit staff discretion
- No jewelry, except a watch and wedding band are permitted; body piercings are permitted at unit staff discretion
- Candy is permitted (max. 1 quart size bag; staff will supervise), no other outside food or beverages are allowed, gum is not permitted
- Videos, DVDs, CDs, musical instruments, portable video games, electronic book readers, cell phones, PDAs, laptops, computers, pagers, Blackberrys are not permitted
- No lighters
- New unopened packages of cigarettes
- Maximum of 2 magazines and/or books without spirals (with appropriate content as approved by the nursing staff)
- Maximum \$30 cash

Please note patients admitted to the Acute Care Unit (ACU) are not permitted to have belts or shoelaces.
